- It is recommended that commenters support their positions with links to relevant information on the Internet. If you have something interesting to share, we'd love to read it!

- We encourage you to add your email address to your post in the appropriate box so we may contact you for further discussion. Your email address will remain private and protected. We don't sell or share your information with anyone else.
- While comments are in open format to encourage free exchange of ideas, we ask that you treat others with respect. If you think our open format is an invitation for trolling, flaming or spamming, don't kid yourself.
